Carbon 12's first solo show of the year goes to the rising Syrian-Canadian, New York-based painter and sculptor Nour Malas. The exhibition will display a series of her powerful abstraction-meets-figuration paintings, tapping into themes of trauma, politics, and the subconscious. "In Evil is Banal," according to the gallery, "Malas beckons the viewer to enter into their own subconscious, our fragile selves wandering in a world that so often feels overwhelming.
